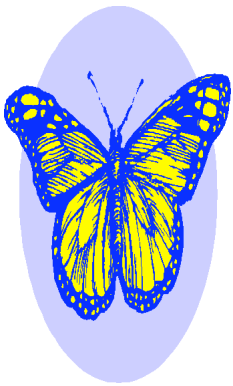
From the President . . .

But we must not become complacent and lose sight of our goals. Each small step in unity is an accomplishment.

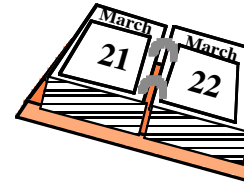
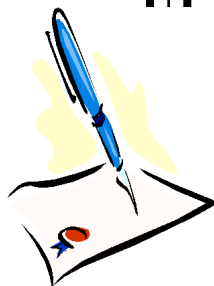
