If the greatest literary minds of all time could not breach that boundary then let us be

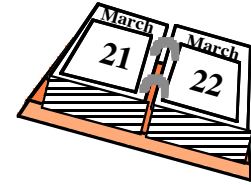
content that mankind will make the same mistakes as before — but, perhaps, not so many.
